

Local technologies on the global stage: Web Summit 2025

Poland will once again mark its presence on the global innovation map. During Web Summit 2025 in Lisbon, one of the world's largest technology events, a Polish National Stand will be set up, where over 50 local institutions, startups, and technology companies will exhibit. This is the largest economic mission of the year, promoting Polish solutions, the Warsaw innovation ecosystem, and the Polish Tech brand on the international stage.

Web Summit is one of the largest and most prestigious technology events in the world. The conference is held annually in Lisbon, attracting over 70,000 participants from 160 countries, including technology industry leaders, investors, startups, representatives of the public sector, and the media.

During this year's edition, which will take place on November 10-13, 2025, thanks to the joint involvement of GovTech Polska at the Ministry of Digital Affairs and the City of Warsaw, a Polish National Stand will be created. Under its umbrella, over 50 business environment institutions, startups, and companies from the national innovation ecosystem will present themselves, making this initiative the largest Polish economic mission in 2025.

The stand will feature zones where entrepreneurs will present their innovative technological solutions. There will also be space for networking and establishing contacts, fostering international cooperation. The program also includes speeches and presentations by representatives of companies, institutions, associations, industry experts, and the Polish Embassy in Lisbon.
